GRAND FINAL PARTICIPANT CONSENT

Grand Final Competition Terms and Conditions:

1. This competition is conducted by Gold Coast Blaze Pty Ltd of Shop 26, Level 1 Oasis Shopping Centre, Broadbeach, Qld, 4218 ABN 76 122 467 289
2. Contestants must be present half an hour before time of competition. Actual competition time will vary depending on the timeframe allocated on the grand final day. Finalists will be notified prior to the event regarding start times for the competition.
3. The Rookie of the Year will be determined by a basketball skills obstacle course. Each finalist will only have one attempt at completing the course. The overall winner will be determined as the fastest time to complete the course. Winners will be notified immediately at the conclusion of the grand final. If the winner is not present in person or fails to present in person within 5 minutes of their name being called at the end of the competition then the winning prize will be allocated to the next fastest time participant and so forth.
4. In an event of a tie situation, the fastest participants will go through the same process again with the new overall fastest time participant determined as the winner. Only one winner will be chosen at the ‘Rookie of the Year’ grand final.
5. Eligibility of competition participants is determined from previous preliminary round tryouts. Entrants must be strictly from 5 years to 13 years of age. Entrants must completely fill in and comply with the participation and grand final competition terms and conditions to be eligible to participate. Failure to comply and partially filled in forms will not be valid or will lead to automatic disqualification.
6. Participants must confirm attendance at least half an hour prior to the grand final. Participants will be notified via telephone if they are not present half an hour prior to the start time. If a finalist is not present in person or fails to present in person at the start of the competition then the competition will commence and the finalist will automatically be disqualified.
7. For ages 5-7 they will use a size 7 ball, the height of the hoop will be at the lowest height and their shooting distance from the hoop will be 2.2m. The passing distance will follow a similar format.
8. For ages 8-10 they will use a size 7 ball, the height of the hoop will be at approx.8 feet and their shooting distance from the hoop will be 3.1m. The passing distance will follow a similar format.
9. For ages 11-13 they will use a size 7 ball, the height of the hoop will be at approx.8 feet and their shooting distance from the hoop will be 4.0m. The passing distance will follow a similar format.
10. The basketball skills obstacle course will consist of (a) Dribbling drill using right hand and left hands (b) Passing drill using a chest pass and (c) Shooting a basket to finish. Each finalist must complete the obstacle course criteria to move onto the next task. The finalist who is the first to finish the course in the shortest time is the winner. Each finalist must complete 2 consecutive laps of (a) (b) (c) above. Time is stopped once the second basket is made.
11. Each Rookie of the Year winner will win a ‘Season Family Pass’ to the 2010/11 Season in the BLUE section valued at \$1116, valid for 2 adults and up to 4 children (15 years and under). Also the Rookie of the Year winner will run out with the Gold Coast Blaze team on the opening night on October 7th 2011 as well as winning their own team jersey and shorts. The winner will be announced at the first home game by the court announcer. The Season Family Pass is upgradable should the winners wish to pay the difference.
12. Prizes are not transferable or redeemable for cash. Season Family Pass seats subject to availability upon booking.
13. Prizes will be announced on the day of the ‘Rookie of the Year’ grand final with the winner collecting their reward after being announced.
14. The results of the ‘Rookie of the Year’ grand final will be published on the Gold Coast Blaze Website, www.blazegc.com.au.
