### Terms and Conditions of Competition

1. This competition is conducted by Gold Coast Blaze Pty Ltd of Shop 26, Level 1 Oasis Shopping Centre, Broadbeach, Qld, 4218 ABN 76 122 467 289
2. Contestants must be present at time of competition. Actual competition time will vary depending on the timeframe allocated at each location of the tryout rounds. Attendees and participants will be notified on the day regarding last minute registration and start times for the competition.
3. Each tryout winner will be determined by a shooting competition. The shooting competition will consist of 5 consecutive attempts at making a basket to score 2 points. The winner will be determined as the highest scorer of the 5. Winners will be notified immediately at the conclusion of the competition. If the winner is not present in person or fails to present in person within 5 minutes of their name being called at the end of the competition then the winning prize will be allocated to the next highest point scorer and so forth.
4. In an event of a tie situation, the highest scoring participants will go through the same process again with the new overall highest scorer determined as the winner. In the event of another tie situation, participants will take one shot at a time between them and the person who misses their basket first will be eliminated from the competition. Only one finalist will be chosen at each preliminary round.
5. Eligibility of competition participants is strictly from 5 years to 13 years of age. Entrants must completely fill in and comply with the participation and competition terms and conditions to be eligible to participate. Failure to comply and partially filled in forms will not be valid or will lead to automatic disqualification.
6. Participants may register with their form prior to the competition via fax, online form ([www.blazegc.com.au](http://www.blazegc.com.au)), telephone call or on the day. Entries close half an hour prior to the beginning of the competition for each round. Participants will be notified of closing time on the day.
7. For ages 5-7 they will use a size 7 ball, the height of the hoop will be at the lowest height and their shooting distance from the hoop will be 2.2m.
8. For ages 8-10 they will use a size 7 ball, the height of the hoop will be at approx.8 feet and their shooting distance from the hoop will be 3.1m.
9. For ages 11-13 they will use a size 7 ball, the height of the hoop will be at approx. 8 feet and their shooting distance from the hoop will be 4.0m.
10. Only one entry at each specific round is allowed per person. Finalists may not register at any other preliminary rounds.
11. The competition will have 5 preliminary rounds, where the 5 finalists will be invited to attend and have the chance to win the 'Rookie of the Year' at the Grand Final to be held at the Gold Coast Show on September 4<sup>th</sup> 2011.
12. Each preliminary round finalist chosen will win a Family Pass to the first home game on October 7<sup>th</sup> 2011 in the Yellow section valued at \$58. The Family Pass ticket is upgradable should the winners wish to pay the difference.
13. Prizes are not transferable or redeemable for cash. Family Pass seats subject to availability upon booking.
14. Prizes will be announced on the day of the preliminary round with the winner collecting their reward after being announced.

### Grand Final Competition Terms and Conditions

1. This competition is conducted by Gold Coast Blaze Pty Ltd of Shop 26, Level 1 Oasis Shopping Centre, Broadbeach, Qld, 4218 ABN 76 122 467 289
2. The Rookie of the Year will be determined by a basketball skills obstacle course. Each finalist will only have one attempt at completing the course. The overall winner will be determined as the fastest time to complete the course. Winners will be notified immediately at the conclusion of the grand final. If the winner is not present in person or fails to present in person within 5 minutes of their name being called at the end of the competition then the winning prize will be allocated to the next fastest time participant and so forth.
3. In an event of a tie situation, the fastest participants will go through the same process again with the new overall fastest time participant determined as the winner. Only one winner will be chosen at the 'Rookie of the Year' grand final.
4. Eligibility of competition participants is determined from previous preliminary round tryouts. Entrants must be strictly from 5 years to 13 years of age. Entrants must completely fill in and comply with the participation and grand final competition terms and conditions to be eligible to participate. Failure to comply and partially filled in forms will not be valid or will lead to automatic disqualification.
5. Participants must confirm attendance at least half an hour prior to the grand final. Participants will be notified via telephone if they are not present half an hour prior to the start time. If a finalist is not present in person or fails to present in person at the start of the competition then the competition will commence and the finalist will automatically be disqualified.
6. For ages 5-7 they will use a size 7 ball, the height of the hoop will be at the lowest height and their shooting distance from the hoop will be 2.2m. The passing distance will follow a similar format.
7. For ages 8-10 they will use a size 7 ball, the height of the hoop will be at approx.8 feet and their shooting distance from the hoop will be 3.1m. The passing distance will follow a similar format.
8. For ages 11-13 they will use a size 7 ball, the height of the hoop will be at approx.8 feet and their shooting distance from the hoop will be 4.0m. The passing distance will follow a similar format.
9. The basketball skills obstacle course will consist of (a) Dribbling drill using right hand and left hands (b) Passing drill using a chest pass and (c) Shooting a basket to finish. Each finalist must complete the obstacle course criteria to move onto the next task. The finalist who is the first to finish the course in the shortest time is the winner. Time is stopped once the first basket is made.
10. The overall 2011/12 Rookie of the Year winner will win a 'Season Family Pass' to the 2011/12 Season in the FUEL section valued at \$1116. Also they will run out with the Gold Coast Blaze team on the opening night on October 7<sup>th</sup> 2011 as well as winning their own team jersey and shorts. The winner will be announced at the first home game by the court announcer. The Season Family Pass is upgradable should the winners wish to pay the difference.
